

- Gas line and control panel installed at the well sites—once a generator and roughly 1,400 feet of pipe laid and tied in, the irrigation system will be fully operational.
- All irrigation equipment stays with the sale.

Farming Rental Income

- The irrigated acres can be leased to a local producer, providing consistent passive income for the owner.
- Currently planted in wheat, this ground can easily be rotated into alfalfa, milo, or other high-yield crops to support both farming and wildlife.
- Additional dryland acres and native grazing pasture add to the ranch's agricultural productivity.

Cattle Operations

- Several strategically placed water tanks ensure a reliable water supply for livestock.
- The rolling grassland between the tillable and river provides ideal grazing with natural windbreaks and abundant forage.




Locator Map




