

### Campsites:

- Sites that include an 'E' after the number have electric hookups.
- The stage & office are no longer on the property following the flood

### Cabin & other buildings:

THE LODGE: The Bearcat Lodge (larger cabin) is setup like a traditional home - 3 bedrooms (1 king & 2 queen beds) & 2 full bathrooms (both with showers). Full kitchen, TV in main living area, laundry room with washer & dryer, screened-in porch with fold-out futon/full bed & huge deck looking out at the horizon. Granite fireplace, hot tub, charcoal grill, outdoor fire pit - the works! It's hard to put a definitive limit on the number of people The Lodge can accommodate, it's an open floor plan and many large groups setup air mattresses.

- Everything in the 2 rental cabins (lodge & cub cabin) will stay, less some art hanging on the wall at the lodge.

THE CUB: Our Cub Cabin (smaller cabin) offers a full bathroom with shower, two full beds & a futon that folds out into a third full bed. Kitchenette & full-size kitchen table, living/dining area with TV, and a deck out front along with a fire pit & charcoal grill.

-The other 2 houses on the property are both 2 bed/1 bath.

### Equipment staying with the property:

- Approx. 70 canoes
- Approx. 18 rafts, some 4-man & some 6-man
- Picnic tables, trash barrels, fire rings
- There's a huge generator that's permanently hooked up to the main house where my caretaker lives. It powers the house when the electric goes out.
