



If you've been looking for a solid piece of ground in St. Helena Parish that checks all the boxes, this 47-acre tract deserves a hard look. With blacktop road frontage and easy access from anywhere in South Louisiana, getting here is simple whether you're slipping away for the weekend or making a quick afternoon hunt. Once you turn in, the property lays out right with a great internal road system that lets you move around with ease, check stands, or just ride and enjoy the place. Toward the back of the property, you'll find Black Creek, and it's exactly what you'd want—lined with big hardwoods that not only look good but hold game. This area is known for producing quality deer and a strong turkey population, and this tract is no exception. The mix of cover and hardwoods along the creek creates natural travel corridors and feeding areas that make it hunt bigger than it is. Whether you're setting up a couple of food plots, hanging stands, or just easing in along the creek bottom, there's no shortage of opportunity here. It's also a great option for a homesite or camp, giving you the chance to build something tucked back with privacy while still having that easy access off a blacktop road. Hard to find a property this clean, this accessible, and this well laid out at this size in this area. If you've been wanting an affordable hunting tract or a place to build and enjoy year-round, this one is worth your time.
