

You have not requested either mediation or reconsideration and field visit and have not waived your rights to mediation or reconsideration within 30 days of receiving the preliminary **Wetland** determination for Farm #5900, Tract #11573, in Dubuque County. As outlined in the procedures and regulations under Title 7 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 12, the preliminary determination has now become **Final**. See the enclosed NRCS-CPA-026 "*Highly Erodible Land and Wetland Conservation Determination*" form for definitions and aerial photo for location(s).

The **Final Technical Determination** is: There are wetland(s) or wetland types as listed on the attached form. If you did not request a wetland determination for your entire farm, wetlands may exist in other locations.

The area(s) designated as wetlands are wetlands because:

- Has a predominance of hydric soils,
- Is inundated or saturated by surface or groundwater at a frequency and duration sufficient to support a prevalence of hydrophytic vegetation typically adapted for life in saturated soil conditions, and
- Under normal circumstances does support a prevalence of such vegetation.

For those sites that are labeled as Farmed Wetland (FW) or Farmed Wetland Pasture (FWP): manipulation has occurred prior to December 23, 1985, see wetland definitions on the NRCS-CPA-026.

This determination is now a **Final Technical Determination**. If you believe that this determination is in error, you may elect to appeal to the Farm Service Agency (FSA) County Committee, or to the National Appeals Division (NAD), at the addresses listed below within 30 calendar days from the date of receipt of this notice.

Your appeal must be in writing and should state clearly what you are appealing and why you believe the Final Technical Determination is not correct. If you do not appeal within 30 days to the FSA County Committee or the National Appeals Division (NAD), no further consideration on the matter will be given.

In order to maintain your eligibility for USDA program benefits, do not perform any land altering activities (tiling, land clearing, ditching, drainage maintenance, filling, leveling, removal of woody vegetation, or dredging) in or adjacent to the identified Wetland (W), Farmed Wetland (FW), Farmed Wetland Pasture or Hayland (FWP) area(s).

This certified wetland determination/delineation has been conducted for the purpose of implementing the Food Security Act of 1985 as amended. This determination/delineation may not be valid for identifying the extent of the United States Army Corps of Engineers (COE) Clean Water Act jurisdiction for this site. If you intend to conduct any activity that constitutes a discharge of dredged or fill material into wetlands or other waters of the United States including lakes, rivers, intermittent or perennial streams, you should request a jurisdictional determination from the Rock Island District COE office prior to starting your work.

You have 30 calendar days from the date of receipt of this letter to make any request as outlined above.


