

- The Property Tax Refund If your taxes exceed certain income-based thresholds, and your total household income is less than \$139,320.
- Special Property Tax Refund If you also owned and occupied this property as your homestead on January 2, 2024 and **both** of the following are true:
 - The net property tax on your homestead increased by more than 12% from 2024 to 2025, and
 - The increase was at least \$100, not due to improvements on the property.

The Senior Citizen Deferral Program provides a low-interest loan to senior citizens having difficulty paying property taxes. This is not a tax forgiveness program, however, this program:

- Limits the maximum amount of property tax paid to 3% of total household income, and
- Ensures the amount of tax paid remains the same as long as you participate in this program.

To be eligible, you must file an application by November 1, 2025, as well as:

- 1. Be at least 65 years old,
- 2. Have a household income of \$96,000 or less, and
- 3. Have lived in your home for at least 5 years.
