DESCRIPTION

BEING a 12.860 acre tract of land siutated in the James Taylor Survey, Abstract No. 553, Montgomery County, Texas, being a portion of a called 33.0 acre tract as described in deed recorded in Volume 773, Page 878 of the Deed Records of Montgomery County, Texas, said 12.860 acre tract being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a concrete monument found in the westerly line of a called 99.11 acre tract as described in deed recorded in Volume 724, Page 592 of said Deed Records for the northeasterly corner of a called 36.66 acre tract as described in deed recorded under Clerk's File No. 2003-005884 of the Official Public Records of Montgomery County, Texas, point also being the southeasterly corner of said 33.0 acre parent tract;

THENCE with the northerly line of 36.66 acre tract South 89° 52′ 00" West a distance of 1622.84 feet to a 1/2 inch iron rod set for the southwesterly corner of the herein described tract;

THENCE severing 33.0 acre tract North 00° 09" 39" East a distance of 16.26 feet passing a 1/2 inch iron rod found for reference, a total distance of 345.28 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod found in the southerly line of a called 33.0 acre tract known as Tract 2 as described in deed recorded in Volume 773, Page 878 of said Deed Records, being the northwesterly corner of the herein described tract;

THENCE with the common line of said 33.0 acre tracts North 89° 52′ 40" East a distance of 1594.66 feet passing a 1/2 inch iron rod found for reference, a total distance of 1623.37 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod found in the westerly line of said 99.11 acre tract and being the northeasterly corner of said 33.0 acre parent tract;

THENCE with the westerly line of 99.11 acre tract South 00° 15′ 00" West a distance of 344.97 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.
