



Take notice that pursuant to Sections 37-90-100 and 108, Colorado Revised Statutes, the Colorado Ground Water Commission is considering issuance of Final Permits for wells listed in this publication. Data for each proposed final permit is only being published in the county in which that well is located. In the main table, the permits are sorted by location. Final permits previously issued by the Commission are not listed since no further action is required for those permits. Some conditional permits in a particular township may not be listed if additional information is required prior to publication for the final permits. The descriptions of irrigated acres have in some cases been simplified for publication purposes. In the following table, Use Code S is for irrigation.
