



Permit nos. 19856-F and 19855-F are presently approved for irrigation of 130 acres each, with annual appropriations of 325 acre-feet each. Permit #19757-F and 20179-F were issued for a common well and the combined acreage permitted is 270 acres, with an annual appropriation of 675 acre-feet.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the request with the condition that the average annual withdrawal from each well does not exceed the annual appropriation of each well.

Final permits previously issued by the Commission are not listed since no further action is required for those permits. Some conditional permits in a particular township may not be listed if additional information is required prior to publication for the final permits.
