



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

The Colorado Ground Water Commission finds that:

1. Pursuant to Section 37-90-108(4) Colorado Revised Statutes, proof was submitted that water was put to beneficial use prior to the expiration date of Permit No. 20512-F, but due to excusable neglect, inadvertence, or mistake, L.D. Dirks failed to submit a statement or evidence of beneficial use on time.
2. A synopsis of the proof was published for two consecutive weeks in a paper of local circulation in each of the affected counties as required by Section 37-90-108(4) C.R.S. and Section 37-90-112 C.R.S. No objections were filed within thirty (30) days.
3. The proof submitted is satisfactory.
4. Conditional Permit No. 20512-F shall remain in force and effect.

Dear Ben:

In April of this year L. D. Dirks filed Amendments of Existing Record to clarify the appropriation and acres irrigated claimed on earlier Statements of Beneficial Use for the wells with the above permit numbers, all located in sec. 18, T9N, R43W. Amendments of Existing Record were requested by our Staff Comments on the permit information sheets to clarify the irrigated acreage.

The original Statements of Beneficial Use were received timely in this office on July 26, 1977. We sought clarification because the original Statements contained strikeovers from 325 to 400 acre-feet in the claims for appropriation and from 130 to 160 acres claimed irrigated. The original Statements clearly showed a 130-acre circle diagrammed on the back.

Since our initial review of these permit files, a District Court decision in the Berens case in Kit Carson County has better defined how the Court will consider such ambiguities. One of the wells in that case had a Statement clearly claiming 160 acres on the Statement face but diagramming a 130-acre circle on the back. The judge allowed only 130-acres. In Mr. Dirks' case, the Amendments of Existing Record clearly diagram the claimed 160 acres, but the original Statement of Beneficial Use diagramming 130 acres remains part of his files.


If, on May 18, 1977, Mr. Dirks actually irrigated the full 160 acres with each of these three wells, we believe it would be better to submit entirely new Statements of Beneficial use. The new Statements should contain a letter from him asking that the original Statements be withdrawn upon acceptance of the new ones. This can be done because the original Statements have not been accepted for filing. Mr. Dirks should be advised that it will be necessary to publish this change and that he will be responsible for the publication costs.

If Mr. Dirks wishes to modify his claims to the originally diagrammed 130 acres and 325 acre-feet, we will need the Amendments of Existing Record clarifying only those two items (the acreage and appropriation) on the face of the Statement of Beneficial Use. These amounts would conform to the diagram of the original Statements. It would not be necessary to publish such a conforming claim.

Enclosed are the Amendments of Existing Record claiming greater amounts than originally shown for you to return to Mr. Dirks. In either case, we will need new forms completed before these permits can be clarified.



With your October 15, 1986, payment of the actual costs of publication to clarify your Permit Nos. 20173-F, 20174-F and 20512-F, you indicated that you felt that the need for this publication was caused by a "goof-up" on the part of the Colorado Ground Water Commission. This is not true.

Publication of your late-filed revised Statements of Beneficial Use was made at your request. It was done to enable you to correct the error in your earlier Statements of Beneficial Use which diagrammed only 130 acres while claiming 160 acres irrigated. The effect of this inconsistency was to make your permit valid for only the 130 acres. Retraction of those timely Statements of Beneficial Use in favor of late filing of revised statements on July 29, 1985, was totally your decision. It was our impression that you were aware that the statute requires publication at the applicant's expense for any such late-filed Statement of Beneficial Use.

Dirks requests to withdraw the Statements of Beneficial Use previously filed on time for permit Nos. 20173-F, and 20174-F, listed as the third, fourth, and fifth items above. 
Enclosed you will find new statements of beneficial uses for the three above referenced irrigation wells in Section 18, Township 9 North, Range 43 West.

In April of this year L. D. Dirks filed Amendments of Existing Record to clarify the appropriation and acres irrigated claimed on earlier Statements of Beneficial Use for the wells with the above permit numbers, all located in sec. 18, T9N, R43W. Amendments of Existing Record were requested by our Staff Comments on the permit information sheets to clarify the irrigated acreage.

The original Statements of Beneficial Use were received timely in this office on July 26, 1977. We sought clarification because the original Statements contained strikeovers from 325 to 400 acres in the claims for appropriation and from 130 to 160 acres claimed irrigated. The original Statements clearly showed a 130-acre circle diagrammed on the back.

Since our initial review of these permit files, a District Court decision in the Berens case in Kit Carson County has better defined how the Court will consider such ambiguities. One of the wells in that case had a Statement clearly claiming 160 acres on the Statement face but diagramming a 130-acre circle on the back. The judge allowed only 130-acres. In Mr. Dirks' case, the Amendments of Existing Record clearly diagram the claimed 160 acres, but the original Statement of Beneficial Use diagramming 130 acres remains part of his files.


If, on May 18, 1977, Mr. Dirks actually irrigated the full 160 acres with each of these three wells, we believe it would be better to submit entirely new Statements of Beneficial use. The new Statements should contain a letter from him asking that the original Statements be withdrawn upon acceptance of the new ones. This can be done because the original Statements have not been accepted for filing. Mr. Dirks should be advised that it will be necessary to publish this change and that he will be responsible for the publication costs.

If Mr. Dirks wishes to modify his claims to the originally diagrammed 130 acres and 325 acre-foot, we will need the Amendments of Existing Record clarifying only those two items (the acreage and appropriation) on the face of the Statement of Beneficial Use. These amounts would conform to the diagram of the original Statements. It would not be necessary to publish such a conforming claim.

Enclosed are the Amendments of Existing Record claiming greater amounts than originally shown for you to return to Mr. Dirks. In either case, we will need new forms completed before these permits can be clarified.
