

ABOUT OWYHEE COUNTY

CLIMATE: Owyhee County enjoys a semi-arid, mild climate with significant seasonal variation in precipitation. The county receives an average of 4 to 18 inches of rain annually. Summers are warm and dry, while winters are cool with potential for snowfall. The area is characterized by a cool season with maximum precipitation and a warm, dry season. Approximately 80,000 acres of productive farmland is possible only with irrigation.


RECREATION: Owyhee County is home to millions of acres of public land and miles of trails and waterways. The beautiful Owyhee River winds through remote areas of the county and is ideal for rafting, fishing, camping, or hiking its majestic canyons. The Snake River forms the north and east boundary of the county and provides unlimited outdoor options as well. Hike or ride horses or off-road vehicles on miles of trails and back roads. Enjoy recreation from Bruneau Dunes State Park to Succor Creek State Park and the Jump Creek recreation area. Hunt big game and birds from elk and mule deer to chukar, upland birds, and waterfowl. Don't say you've been to Owyhee County unless you visit the famous mining town of Silver City.


