Enclosed please find a copy of your application for a sewage disposal permit. Written installation plans must be submitted to this office for review and approved by an Environmental Sanitarian prior to a sewage disposal system permit being issued.

Upon installation plan approval for new home construction, applicant must obtain property address from Madison County Planning Commission. Following plan approval and the office receiving a property address, applicant may purchase a sewage disposal permit.

When this process is complete, you may purchase your permit for \$150.00 (\$100.00 permit fee and \$50.00 inspection fee – correct change, check or money order) from our office. No work shall be started on the sewage disposal system until a sewage disposal permit is purchased. Upon completion, a representative of our office will conduct a final inspection of the system before the system is covered. No system shall be installed during adverse weather and/or soil conditions.
