Good morning, I have attached a drawing of what it would look like to get electric to the property you mention the other day. Hopefully this will help give reference to the power situation here. Pennyrile Electric currently provides 1,000' free to provide power to a residence. It can not be a camper and septic will be required for us to consider it residential. The right of way clearing will not be free. We would have our contractors quote the job which consist of clearing a 40' path for us, based on the line designers route, and that cost would be passed on to the member requesting power. After the first thousand feet of free build out, the remaining cost would come in at \$10.50 per ft. One of the main challenges will be obtaining an easement for Pennyrile electric to clear right of way and be granted permission to have a new power line there. We have the Easement form but our policy states that it is the members responsibility to get them signed. I hope this helps. If you have any other questions please let me know.
