In the evening, enjoy relaxing and listening to East Birch Creek that flows through the middle of the property and watch for the abundant wildlife that visits frequently. Take a ride in your side-by-side, or horse up the road to the Umatilla National Forest, where you can find endless recreation and trails to take advantage of. Pilot Rock has a small community atmosphere with multiple stores, a gas station, excellent schools, and local services. There are a lot of unique features to this property that make it exciting, but without a doubt, the most significant feature is the ability to live in a peaceful area that takes advantage of the small-town atmosphere and the country way of life. The Seller does not have a well log. A new Even-flow pump that costs approximately 5k was just put in. The Evenflow pump has a variable frequency drive design that allows more water to be pumped when using multiple water appliances in the house. Septic Tank: The Seller had Arnie's install new plumbing to the septic less than two years ago. The creek splits the property into two 1 +/- acre pastures. The west pasture across the stream is sub-irrigated and produces good grass. Historically, the sellers fenced this pasture off with temporary fencing and used this during the late spring and summer months. The east side pasture was recently reconstructed with new fill material to raise the ground level. The Seller had hoped to reseed the ground and fence it off for horses but did not get that far. According to the Umatilla County water master, no water rights are currently available. Buyer to do their due diligence on any and all water right findings associated with the property. 3/4 of the property is fenced The property owners have seen a variety of wildlife on the property, including deer, elk, cougar, fox, coyotes, turkeys, and grouse. The owner speaks of the wildlife activity as one of the main joys of the property. "You are far enough out from town, and with the creek right there, you see a bit of everything! It really is beautiful and fun." East Birch Creek: East Birch Creek flows through the middle of the property and is a primary water source for wildlife and livestock alike throughout the year. The owner said the water gets low in the late summer months but has never seen the creek go completely dry. The creek has a deep spot used by the sellers in the summer months as a place to relax, cool off, and swim. Flooding: The property



is not in a flood zone and does not need flood insurance. The Sellers have said that the house has never flooded. Extra fill material was brought into the property to help make a significant berm along the creek to help keep the water where it is supposed to be. Nearby Recreation- (Hunting and Fishing) Umatilla National Forest: Not far south from the property is the Umatilla National Forest, where you will find miles of forest roads that can be used to travel up to Ukiah, OR, and/or beyond. The Umatilla National Forest is known for its wildlife and endless recreation, from wild mushroom or huckleberry picking, to the many hunting spots the public uses. Indian Lake: Indian Lake (Lake Hiyuumptipin) is operated by the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation and is located not far southeast of the property on the Umatilla Indian Reservation. Lake Hiyuumptipin (which translates as "grizzly bear devouring") offers a relaxing atmosphere to camp, picnic, fish, and or boat in the Blue Mountains southeast of Pilot Rock, OR. At an elevation of 4,200 feet, the Indian Lake Recreation Area lies near the crest of the Blue Mountains. Buyers must do their due diligence into licenses required by the tribe to fish and camp there. Pilot Rock: Welcome to the City of Pilot Rock "The Rock," as it is known to locals, can be seen from the base of the Blue Mountains on a clear day 12 miles away. The City of Pilot Rock was named for the prominent basalt rock formation located on the west side of the town, which was visible from the old Oregon Trail and used as an aim point by wagon trains traveling Emigrant Pass and Cabbage Hill.Pilot Rock is located in Northeastern Oregon, approximately 15 miles south of Pendleton, in the foothills of the Blue Mountains. It is a small community of 1,505. The primary industries are timber and agriculture. Pilot Rock is home to one mill: Woodgrain Lumber. Rolling hills of grassland and grain fields depict the land at the Blue Mountains' base. Pilot Rock is located at the confluence of East and West Birch Creek, tributaries of the Umatilla River.

The population was 1,502 at the 2010 census."
