

# The Circle-L South Ranch A Premier Recreational Property





Nestled at the soul of Circle-L South Ranch, The Lodge is a warm haven built for laughter-filled weekends, roaring fires, and stories that stretch past midnight. Downstairs, a sprawling great room wraps you in the glow of a massive brick fireplace, where a custom pool table beckons friendly rivalry and the chef's kitchen stands ready to feed a hungry hunting party or a holiday crowd. Slip upstairs to four cozy bedrooms, spilling onto a wide balcony that drinks in the sunset over the stocked pond. Outside, a covered patio, shady porches, and a stone firepit invite easy evenings under the stars, marshmallows optional but highly recommended. The Lodge isn't just a building—it's the heartbeat of memories waiting to happen.





The Mason House is a charming 1941 time capsule steeped in family legacy, where echoes of early-20th-century sharecroppers still linger near the remnants of their original homestead on the northern border. This cozy 1,626 sq ft retreat offers three bedrooms, one bath, a sunny sunroom, inviting living room, den/office, and a full kitchen with dining nook—perfect as overflow guest quarters for weekend escapes or longer ranch stays. Step out onto the classic front porch or relax on the back deck, all protected by a whole-house Generac generator, with appliances and select furnishings conveying to welcome your guests the moment they arrive.




# The Land: A Sportsman's Dream and Smart Investment




Circle-L South Ranch is a wildliferich playground, drawing deer. turkev. small game, and the occasional bear to three strategically placed food plots (4.62 acres total) fed by gravity feeders and overlooked by elevated box blindsall connected by a quiet mile of interior roads and trails. Roughly 70 acres of managed planted pines, recently thinned and nearing harvest age, promise excellent future timber returns, while the balance of mature oaks, hickory, walnut, and wild persimmons creates a mast-rich habitat that keeps game on the property year-round. The 1.5-acre pond stocked with bass, catfish and bream, complete with floating dock, adds fishing and pure enjoyment to the ranch's long list of outdoor pursuits.





From the moment you enter the keypad-gated paved driveway, every detail is designed for convenience and self-sufficiency: a 30×30 insulated workshop with roll-up door and heater, a 30×36 pole barn with concrete floors and electricity, a dedicated skinning shed with walk-in cooler, a safe 100-yard rifle range with shooting shed, on-site fuel station (300 gal gas + 300 gal diesel), and covered parking—all finished to the same high standard and topped with a running-buck weathervane that says this place was made for hunters who love the life.







Circle-L South Ranch is that rare turnkey legacy property where every detail — from the timeless custom lodge and historic Mason House to the managed timber, abundant wildlife, and hunter-ready infrastructure — has been thoughtfully built for multi-generational enjoyment and self-sufficient country living. With thriving wildlife, income-producing pines, and pond it delivers both recreation and long-term investment potential without requiring any improvement. In short, it's a ready-made retreat where family memories, big hunts, and financial returns all come together the day you close.
